What is Grand Rapids Triathlon?

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Grand Rapids Triathlon (GRTri) is a two-day swim, bike, run event on June 10th & 11th in Ada Township.

Since 2011, we are the premier and largest independent triathlon in Michigan and host to 5 USA Triathlon National Championships and numerous USAT state championships.

We also host a Youth Duathlon as part of the event for kids 6-11.



Who are our athletes?

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Triathletes are upper-income earners, highly educated, responsive to marketing, and a mobile segment.

Average household income is \$161,300.

 Triathletes spend an average of \$3,500 on sporting goods and athletics per year.

 40-44: median age of a triathlete with almost a 50/50 split between men and women at this event.

Where do they come from?

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GRTri has a national reach with a strong regional base.

•We attract athletes from 41 states and multiple countries including Canada, Argentina, Brazil and the Netherlands.


- •60% of our athletes are within 50 miles of the Grand Rapids area.

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Hosting multiple distance events increases athlete participation

 Only event to host long-distance tris as well as newbie-friendly distances catering to all levels of participants.

We are the only two-day event

 Hosting over an entire weekend gives unprecedented sponsorship exposure to our athletes.

 Often chosen to host USA Triathlon state, regional and national championships due to our highly respected event.
