



FESTIVAL OF TREES 2026

Legacy Park – Ada
December 1st – 31st

The ABA will supply one potted live tree, 100 pre-hung white LED string lights, and signage with your group, organization or company logo. Pre-registration is required. Space is limited.

Participants are asked to decorate their tree using the following guidelines:

1. Trees will be available for decorating from **9am to 4pm, November 20th – November 30th**. Please plan to have your tree completely decorated by **4pm, on November 30th**. All trees must be decorated on-site at Legacy Park.
2. Be creative! This a great opportunity to showcase your business or organization. Decorations can be homemade or purchased – they will be exposed to winter weather. Be sure they are made of materials that can withstand snow, moisture, and wind.
3. A 4ft foot live, potted tree and lights will be provided by the ABA. We ask that no additional lights be added. Approximate height – this is dependent on the growing season.
4. **Tree location will be assigned** and will be provided by email prior to November 20th.
5. Decorations designed to feed wildlife, or that could harm wildlife, are not allowed. Do not use any food items on your tree.
6. Decorations should be tied or wired securely to your tree (not to light strings) to resist high winds, rain, snow, and vandalism. Standard ornament hangers are not adequate. **Please plan to check on your tree occasionally, to note the status of your decorations.**
7. No décor may be staked into the ground due to park irrigation lines. Yard signs promoting your business are allowed.
8. No political decorations or statements.
9. The ABA will not be responsible for lost or damaged decorations.
10. Participants are responsible for removing your decorations between **January 1st – 5th**. Any decorations not picked up by **4pm on January 5th**, will not be returned.
